

Letchworth 3rds 262-7 (46.0 overs) vs Potters Bar 3rds 54-1 (10.0 overs). Match abandoned.

On a muggy afternoon at Dame Alice Owens School, Letchworth 3rds won the toss and elected to bat. The Letchworth batsmen took advantage of a true wicket and a fast outfield to accumulate runs steadily. However Potters Bar's medium pacer Rupert Pyrah took advantage of some seam movement to make inroads into the Letchworth batting line-up.

At 101-5 it looked as though Potters Bar might have broken the back of the Letchworth batting, but Letchworth's number three Gordon had started to hit the ball hard and supported by Moore (53*) added 103 for the 6th wicket in just 14 overs. Gordon eventually departed for 145 when he played across a straight one from Hayden Rogers. Letchworth eventually declared at 262-7, leaving Potters Bar 54 overs to chase the target. Rupert Pyrah was the pick of the bowlers taking 5-101 before succumbing to a back injury attempting to take a caught and bowled.

Potters Bar also took advantage of a good wicket with skipper John Lewis and Hayden Rogers putting on a rapid 38 for the first wicket. An exciting run chase looked on the cards, but at 5.30 with lightning flashing around the ground, the heavens opened and the match was abandoned. Rogers top scored with 23*. Both sides claimed 10 points apiece.
