

Barnet under 11s entertained Potters Bar on Tuesday 26th June. The toss was won by Potters Bar who elected to bat. Luke McGee and James Ilott opened the batting in the usual fashion, scoring at 6 an over. However in the 4th over Luke McGee was unfortunately clean bowled for 10 which was a disappointing score for the talented cricketer. George Scott entered the crease and batted with great maturity, never failing to perform. James and George kept the rate at over 6, with the score after 10 overs being 69 for 1. The first ball of the 11th over brought a wicket for Barnet with James Ilott being out lbw playing across the line, it got worse for Bar when George Scott was run out for 39. One run later Bradley Ray was bowled meaning Bar had slipped from 86 for 2 to 87 for 5. For the last 6 overs Dan Mackey and Luke Jupp batted brilliantly and pushed the singles to get to 120 off the 20 overs. Credit has to go to Barnet who bowled in the right areas and didn't give many extras away.

Bar opened the bowling with Luke Jupp and James Ilott. James struck early to reduce the hosts to 8 for 1 off 2 overs allowing Bar to never let Barnet control the game at any stage. Barnet lost wickets at regular intervals with the pick of the bowlers being Luke McGee who took 3 for 11 off 4. All 6 bowlers bowled in the right places with very few extras, paired with excellent fielding and with George Scott hitting the stumps directly twice to run out two Barnet batsmen. The next game is a big game for the boys against North London in the Cup Final on Monday.
